#### ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- \*Purpose of collection is to promote awareness of Coast Salish art, and support the artists who are reviving it. (George & Christiane Smyth)
- \*Objective is for teachers to bring them to the classroom and integrate this art into the curriculum, at all levels and in all subjects. (George & Christiane Smyth)
- \*Diversity of designs is a testament to the vast possibilities of Coast Salish art. (DylanThomas)
- \*Distinct Elements & Shapes of CS Art include: the concentric circle & oval, the crescent, and the trigon (triangle with rounded sides (DylanThomas)
- \*Spirit of the Spindle Whorl, which symbolizes the creation and distribution of wealth in the form of weaving within Coast Salish communities. The woven blankets created with spindle whorls by Coast Salish women were a form of currency that validated and documented wealth within a community. (lessLie)
- \*In Salish culture, Thunderbird lives symbolically with Lightning Snake under its wing, where one sees lighting, that is Thunderbird and Lightning Snake hunting large game such as killer whales. (Chris Paul)
- \*Thunderbird is a symbol of awe and respect for nature. (lessLie)
- \*The horn is the distinguishing feature between Thunderbird and Eagle. Thunderbird has a horn. (lessLie)
- \*Circular form & number four as with many FN cultural beliefs, symbolizes holism and balance. (lessLie)
- \*A common design tradition of Coast Salish art is the utilization of concentric circles within the anatomical joints of the depicted beings to show points of connection. (lessLie)
- \*Some prints can be interpreted as visually revealing the human roots of some animals, since in some Coast Salish cultures, the original beings of the world were human, and were transformed by the Transformer into animal forms (lessLie)
